Dear Sigma Pi Fraternity:

On Wednesday, November 18, 2020, you accepted responsibility for violating the following University Conduct Rule(s) and Regulation(s):

Student Organizational Conduct
Violation of Other University Policies (Unregistered Event)
Disregard for University Authority

As such, you have been issued the following sanctions:

- You are required to pay a \$960 fine;
- Each member (at the time of the incident) is required to re-complete COVID-19 virtual training;
- Each member (at the time of the incident) is required to receive a mini coaching session with a C-19 Ambassador; and
- Each member (at the time of the incident) is required to participate in the “Stop the Spread: COVID-19 Awareness Seminar.”

You have to January 19, 2021 to complete these outcomes. Failure to complete the sanctions by due date could lead to additional conduct charges.

The Ole Miss Chapter of Sigma Pi is responsible for the fine in the amount of \$960 (\$20 fine times 48 members). The check should be payable to UM Foundation with the memo line: "DOS Risk Management Fund #06329" and can be delivered to the Dean of Students at Lyceum 233. The fine is due no later than **December 7, 2020**.
