Dear Campus Outreach Ole Miss Organization:

On Tuesday, September 7, 2021, you accepted responsibility for violating the following University Conduct Rule(s) and Regulation(s):

Noise Violation Student Organizational Conduct Violation of Other University Policies (Unregistered Event)

As such, you have been issued the following sanctions:

- You have been issued a disciplinary warning. This warning is a written notice given to draw your attention to the fact that your behavior was not appropriate with University policy. Please understand that should a breach of University policy occur again or you are found responsible for any future offenses, you may expect to receive more severe disciplinary action.
- To increase your understanding of how your behavior impacted others and the community, you are required to complete a presentation on the event registration process and what the organization should have done. The presentation can be in a video format or a powerpoint format. If it were a physical presentation, it should last 15 minutes. It is due no later than 5PM on October 8, 2021.
- Effective immediately, you have been placed on disciplinary probation through October 8, 2021 or upon completion of the educational project. During this probationary period, if you are found responsible for violating any University policy, the violation will be dealt with more severely.

You will be held accountable for completing all of the sanctions as described. Failure to comply with sanctions may result in additional charges from the Office of Conflict Resolution and Student Conduct.
