Dear Delta Psi Fraternity:

On Wednesday, October 11, 2017, you took responsibility for violating the following University Conduct Rule(s) and Regulation(s):

Student Organizational Conduct

The sanctions are as following:

- Provide proof of a restructured, detailed new member education program, to the Office of Conflict Resolution and Student Conduct by Friday, October 20, 2017.
- Provide a detailed letter of what constitutes as hazing to your new member classes for the next three years. The letter needs to be approved by the Office of Conflict Resolution and Student Conduct seven days prior to bid day.
- Host the lecture on Sunday, October 15, 2017 that includes the Delta Psi [REDACTED], along with various organization advisors. A summary of the event needs to be turned into the Office of Conflict Resolution and Student Conduct on Monday, October 16, 2017 and signed by chapter leadership, Delta Psi [REDACTED], and the University advisor.

If you wish to dispute any of these sanctions, or if the summary of this email differs from your recollection, you must contact me via email within 48 hours. Students who do not complete sanctions within the time frame required are subject to additional conduct charges from the Office of Conflict Resolution and Student Conduct.

I hope that this has been an educational experience for you and that even while you may disagree with the outcome, you experienced an equitable process in alignment with our community values identified in the Creed. If you have questions concerning the decision, sanctions, or appeal
